
#### Behaviour

### **Canteen News**

It is great to report the canteen is donating a very good quality soccer ball and an encyclopaedia to the School. This is the result of a Parmalat Milk promotion the Canteen entered. Parmalat is the milk company that supplies our school with plain, chocolate, strawberry and vanilla malted milk. Our price has remained at \$1.60 for the past two years, even though the recommended retail price is \$1.90. Unfortunately, next year we will have to increase to \$1.80.

The canteen is about to receive a welcome addition. A display refrigerator will be placed in the main

serving area. This will save volunteers some walking, time and also help visual sales of products.

Last week I mentioned the problems associated with students filling out recess and lunch orders at the canteen. This is a very important issue. I do not have many volunteer helpers so consequently I do not have sufficient time to help the children make healthy decisions. I therefore ask again that parents buy lunch bags and write them out at home please. We need a separate bag for recess and lunch. At the canteen bags cost 40cents for 10.
