Principal's Report

Staff Training

Even though this is a particularly busy term, our staff is continuing to be trained in various professional development areas. We are currently completing the SENA testing, which is a maths based assessment and will be shortly completing the North Coast Spelling with a consultant visiting our school. In completing these two areas of the curriculum we are also evaluating data from NAPLAN testing. Our staff are continually working to ensure the students at Coffs Harbour Public School are receiving the best quality teaching and learning programs available.

Our classroom teachers are using these results to complete semester 2 reports.

We are also in the process of changing to new finance and student wellbeing administrative programs. To this end, our office staff will be attending intensive training over the next couple of weeks. In addition we will be unable to complete any financial transactions from Wednesday 6th November until Friday 15th November. We appreciate your understanding during this period.
