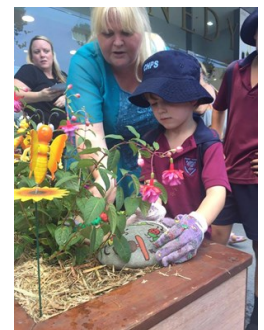
Kindergarten Graduation
