Personal Best Badge	1 per Class per Term presented at the PB Assembly     A special Badge which is presented for exceptional students who reflect in their attitude and achievement the values of our school community. It is for consistent and exemplary effort and/or results that indicate that they have reached a high personal goal in ability, academic results, social co-operation and/or improvement. PB is equivalent to 2 Merit Awards.
