What's happening in K - 1 B!

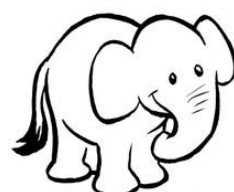

FISH FROM HEAVEN

A mullet about a foot long fell from above and struck a child on the head at Coffs Primary School about midday a few days ago. It looked like 'fish from heaven' and the headmaster, an ardent amateur fisherman, wondered how it had happened until a glance skyward provided the answer. The two sea eagles often seen flying over Coffs Harbour were in sight and an examination of the fish, not long dead, revealed claw marks on the body. The eagles had apparently dropped a tasty meal.
