
KW's Tadpoles

I like the tadpoles because they turn in to a frog. The tadpoles is goe to get big.





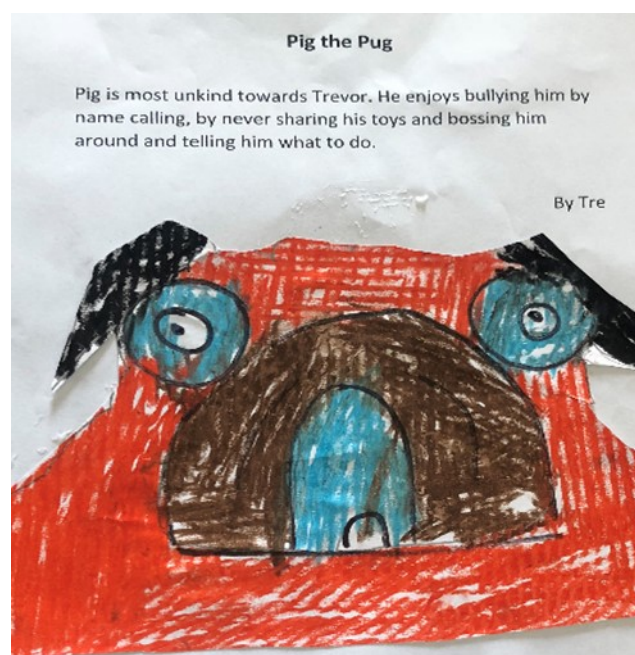
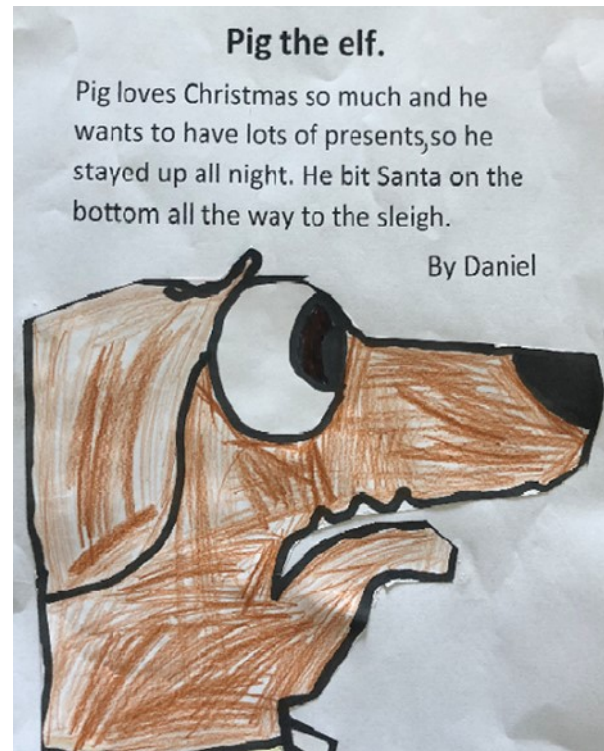
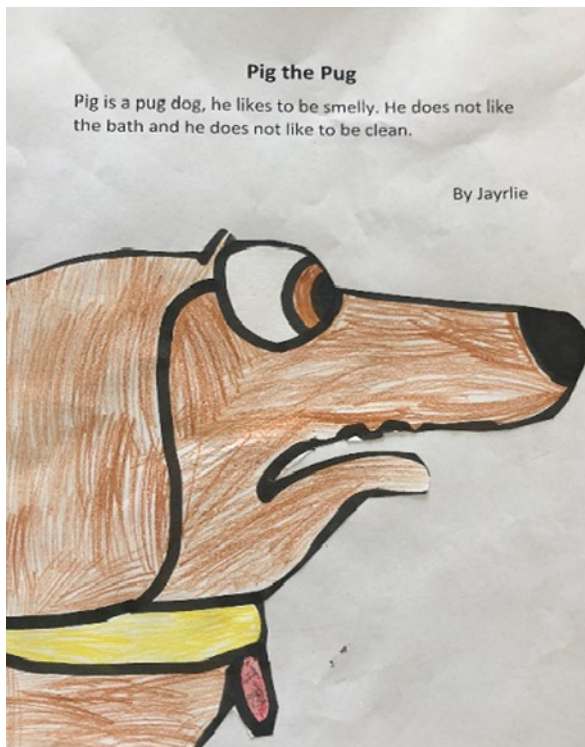
