- Students may be collected from 3.00pm or go home on the bus from 3.20pm.

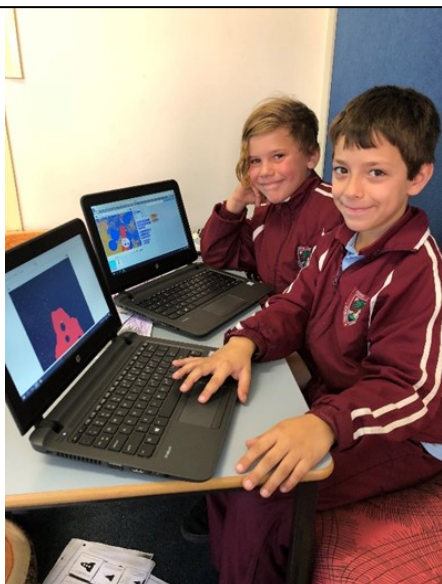
