# **Food Smart Program**



Hi everyone,

Many of our Food Waste families have completed their first food waste audit and are now using their FREE Food Smart kits to reduce their food waste at home. It's easy, saves you money and helps the environment!

#### Best Before and Use Buy dates

Food labels did not even exist when our Grannies were around and they would never have thrown good food away, so why should we? Of course, we don't want people eating mouldy food, but relying on labels alone will always lead to good food ending up in the bin.

Know the difference between use-by and best before dates.

#### **BEST BEFORE = QUALITY**

The food supplier's recommendation of when the product is at its 'best', it's perfectly safe to eat after this date.

#### USE-BY = safety

The manufacturers guide to when the product should be consumed for food safety reasons. Whilst it's not really recommended to eat food past this date, use your senses to gauge whether food is edible. Keep up the great work!

#### Beeswax Wrap Workshop

Our school will be hosting two FREE beeswax wrap workshops for those families who have registered with the Food Smart Program. The session will include how to make the wraps and making some of your own. Book now as there are limited spots for both sessions.

Our next P&C meeting will be held on Wednesday 12th Sep at 6pm in the staff room.


