




Major Works Update

The Framework has gone up for the new classrooms with sheeting to commence shortly.






Kindergarten Bus Safety Program

Keeping Your Child Safe - Road Safety

The school community is concerned about ways to make our morning drop off routine safer. Cars should not enter the bus zone between 8am - 9:30am & 2:30pm - 4pm.



This means that children can use the crossing safely without cars entering the area. The best place to drop your child off in the **morning**, is further down Salamander Street.



In the **afternoon** children line up and are led down by a teacher to Curacoa Street where parents are able to park easily and safely. This is suitable for K-6 students.



Just a reminder with 'No parking' areas around the school -

You must not stop for more than two minutes in a No Parking area. You must remain in or within 3 metres of the vehicle. Hours of operations may apply to some signs. This means restrictions apply for those times only. Mobility Parking Permit holders are allowed to park for up to 5 minutes in a No Parking area. Please follow the rules and take care so our students and community can continue to be safe around our school.
