What a fantastic day we had on Friday last week with The Colour Run. It was very well organised by Mrs Leman and the entire school including students and staff had a great day. To date there has been \$13700 raised and the school should get approximately \$10000 after all expenses have been taken out. This will certainly assist us to buy some new resources for the library. Thank you so much to everyone who participated.

Intensive swimming lessons started today and will continue for the next two weeks. Please make sure your child comes dressed to school with their swimmers on and a labelled bag has their underwear and towel. Over the years we have found that the improvement is incredible as each child is able to practise their skills for 10 consecutive days. Thank you to the many staff who are supporting the students in this very worthwhile program.

Kindergarten 2021 transition lessons will start this Friday. We are very mindful of the COVID guidelines and ask that all parents sign their child into school just before 9.15am and then return to pick them up at 10.30am. Children must be enrolled to attend Kinder transition. So if you haven't had an enrolment meeting with myself or one of the Assistant Principals please ring the school office and we will happily organise one. Currently we have over sixty students enrolled for 2021 Kindergarten.

This week we will be having a new shed built to store all of our sports equipment.
