Dear Parents and Carers,


This year we are delving deeper to look at our attendance data and provide information to our parents and carers about the expectations for student attendance. 95% + is our expected student attendance every day. Did you know that students with attendance rates below 90% may be educationally at risk?



"95% attendance = not more than 2.5 days absence per term"



This data below shows the percentages of students' attendance.



This data shows 208 students (45.61%) out of 504 students are currently siting at 95% or more attendance. This is a fantastic achievement. We currently have 67.1% of our students attending school 90% or more this term.

IT is interesting to note that 32.9% of our students are attending school 80% or less of the time.

In term 1 this year, we had 65.9% of students attending school 90% or more. Congratulations to our school community for this improvement from our term 1 data.

Our end of year goal is to have 72% of our students attending school 90% of the time.

New School Attendance Initiatives

We are happy to share with you some new initiatives that we will be implementing in line with our new School Improvement Plan with the aim to boost our attendance rates. This will include sharing celebrations each fortnight for the grade that has the highest attendance rate and also shining a spotlight on the class that has the highest attendance rate. This is an exciting new initiative and we look forward to sharing this news with you all each fortnight.


'Mrs Anderson's Article'






5/6H News

We have listened to and performed a range of different songs in order to understand the importance of pitch, melody and tempo. Pitch is how high or low a note sounds. A melody is the tune created when high and low notes are played together. It is usually the part of the song that is most recognisable and tempo is the speed at which a piece of music is played. We have explored how different artists use pitch, melody and tempo in different ways in order to help the listener connect with their music. In week 4, we presented this information on assembly and performed a song using Boomwhackers.
