My husband, Karl, is also retiring and we plan to travel, breathe deeply, sleep well, relax, exercise more and see more of Australia and overseas. I will be taking long service leave from 9 June 2023 and then move into retirement.

So, whilst I am not leaving the school for a few more months, I wanted you to hear the news from me.

Moving into year 7 in a NSW Government school in 2024

If you would like your child to attend a government high school in 2024, you will need to complete an expression of interest for Year 6 to 7 transition. The expression of interest lets you indicate which school (s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7 Most NSW Government schools have local enrolment areas with geographical boundaries. Your child's permanent residential address determines which high school's boundary they fall within. After you submit this expression of interest and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a government high school.

Please note: The last day for submission is 31 March 2023

Completing an expression of interest lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7. After you submit the expression of interest and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a government high school.

Mrs Viv Eddie and Mrs Nic Bennett will be available on Friday 24 March to offer assistance in filling out your expression of interest.

Most NSW Government schools have local enrolment areas with geographical boundaries. We can assist you with finding your local school based on your home address.

Your child is entitled to a place at their local high school. However, it is still important that you complete the expression of interest so that Coffs Harbour Public School can support your child's transition.

Please note: The expression of interest closes on 31 March 2023, so please come and see us for assistance.


